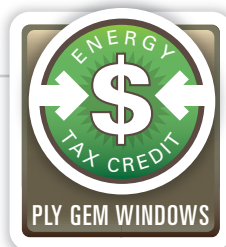


FEDERAL ENERGY TAX CREDIT

PLY GEM REPLACEMENT WINDOWS

has multiple products that meet or exceed federal energy tax credit requirements of a U-Factor rating of .30 or lower and a Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) rating of .30 or lower.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR HOMEOWNERS

- Up to \$1,500 maximum credit for windows for all taxable years.
- Allowed only for amounts paid or incurred to purchase the window or door.
- Not allowed for amounts paid for onsite preparation, assembly, original installation labor, other components or sales tax.
- This credit is valid on products purchased and installed between January 1, 2009, and December 31, 2010.
- The purchase must be made during the taxable year for which the credit is claimed.

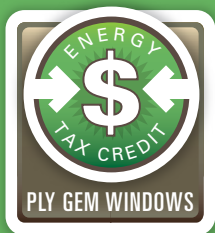

NOTE: Ply Gem Premium replacement double hung windows with upgrade to the Energy Package reinforced and insulated sash option combined with the HP glass option (single lite Low-E/argon) meets the energy tax credit requirements with a .30 U Factor/.29 SHGC.

FEDERAL ENERGY TAX CREDIT

To qualify for the federal energy tax credit, replacement windows and/or patio doors must have both a U-Factor rating of .30 or lower and a Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) rating of .30 or lower. This credit is valid on products purchased and installed between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2010.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR HOMEOWNERS

- Up to \$1,500 maximum credit for windows for all taxable years.
- Allowed only for amounts paid or incurred to purchase the window or door.
- Not allowed for amounts paid for onsite preparation, assembly, original installation labor, other components or sales tax.
